Pre-programmed code in SoSciSurvey:

- 1 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- 2 = I think this sounds natural
- 3 = I think this does not sound natural
- 4 = I'm sure this does not sound natural

Re-coding needs to be done with the correct test items T101 01 to T101 09

- T101 01 (A) 1. Do you have any homework today? 4 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- T101_02 (A) 2. Do you know anyone at that school? 4 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- T101_03 (A) 3. I haven't heard anything from Jane for weeks. 4 = I'm sure this sounds natural

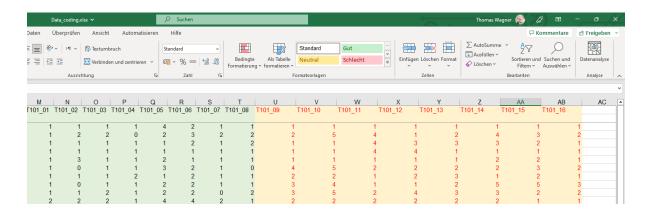
The original coding can remain with the test items T101 09 to T101 16

- T101_09 (A) 9. I've heard any news about the campaign. 1 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- T101 10 (A) 10. The policemen found anything at the crime scene. 1 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- T101_11 (A) 11. Anyone has not finished their homework. 1 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- T101_12 (A) 12. Anyone did not follow the instructions. 1 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- T101_13 (A) 13. The journalist believed of the singer. 1 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- T101_14 (A) 14. I suppose that you said anything to Sam last night. 1 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- T101 15 (A) 15. Lucy probably bought anything last week. 1 = I'm sure this sounds natural
- T101 16 (A) 16. I probably saw anyone at the weekend. 1 = I'm sure this sounds natural

And these items need to be deleted altogether

How to invert Likert values in Excel



For items T101_01 to T101_09, the numbers that SoSciSurvey gave each response need to be inverted; the 1s need to become 4s, and vice versa. With 4 Likert points going from 1 to 4, we simply can type =5-U3 into the cell AC3 in the above example. This would give us the number 4 in this cell. Then, click your mouse on this small square handle in the bottom-right corner of this cell and drag it down all the way to the last observation in this column while you press the mouse button. Thereby, you apply the same formula to the other cells in this column. You do the same for items T101_02 to T101_9.
