

Handout 3 – assignments

In the course of this proseminar, you are supposed to submit *three* assignments. They will all be assessed individually and are part of your final mark.

Assignment 1: *Reading test*

For assignment 1, you are supposed to read a real academic research paper. We will discuss this paper in class, then you will be quizzed on this text by means of a short Moodle test about the paper's structure and contents.

Assignment 2: *Research report*

You will write up a small-scale applied linguistics research project as a report and submit it in a MS WORD document directly via Moodle. It needs to be written up in a special MS WORD template (s. Moodle) in 1000 words \pm 10%.

Assignment 3: *Project talks*

Towards the end of the course, you will present the current state of your research project (method, items, preliminary findings etc.) in an individual brief talk with the instructor. For this talk you will prepare and bring a one-page handout, printed out only! Your talk will be formally assessed according to content, language use, and presentation (for assessment scale s. Moodle).
