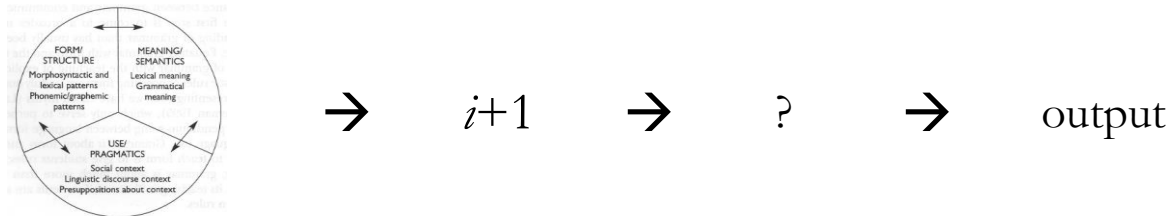

2 Have you provided self-made input in one of your classes? What else would be 'suitable' input? What role do the following criteria play?

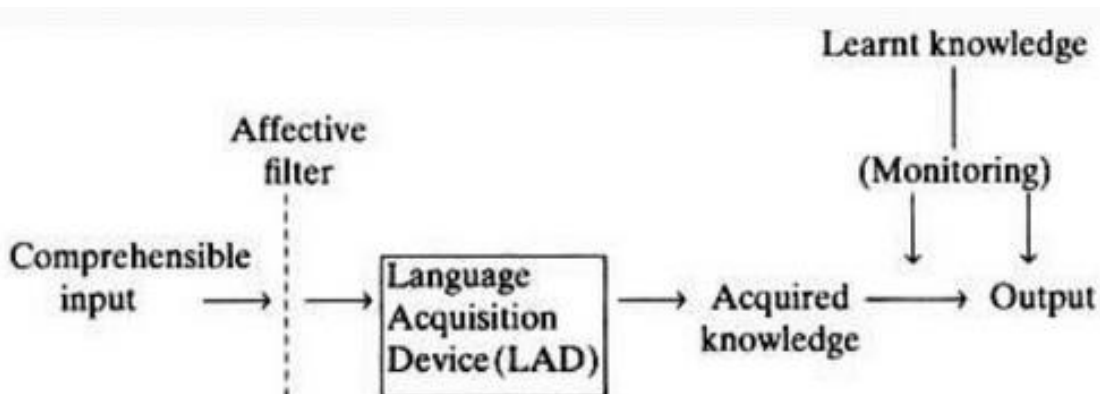
- (a) Interest
